Dear Ellen,

The Executive Committee of the Nebraska Children's Commission respectfully submits the attached data and information request on behalf of the Juvenile Services Committee. As you know, this Committee has been charged by statute to examine the out-of-home placements and system of care in the juvenile justice system. The information and data requested is necessary to make informed recommendations to improve outcomes for children and families in Nebraska.

We request that the Administrative Office of Probation respond before or at the November Juvenile Services Committee meeting, on November 8, 2016. Your response will be used to inform the creation of recommendations related to the juvenile justice continuum of care, including out-of-home placements and the role of the Youth Rehabilitation and Treatment Centers (YRTCs). These issues are of high importance to the Committee and Legislature, and current and accurate information from Probation will support recommendations to improve and enhance juvenile justice in Nebraska.

QUESTIONS FOR PROBATION

- 1. Process across the State used to determine placement recommendation at YRTC
 - a. Information or insight about whether we have statewide uniformity of Probation recommendation process and court finding/court process to commit youth to YRTC
 - b. What are the court processes across the State related to commitments?
- 2. What information/documentation is given to YRTC at time of commitment
 - a. What, if any, assessments are completed by Probation immediately prior to commitment
- 3. Involvement of Probation with youth while placed at YRTC
 - a. Data on contacts, visits, and team meetings by probation officers while youth placed at YRTC
 - b. Data/information on probation involvement with family while youth placed at YRTC
 - c. Information regarding involvement of probation officers with YRTC treatment planning team & process for youth placed at YRTC
- 4. Re-entry Process
 - a. Where types of placements (including home) are youth going to when leave YRTC
 - i. Any Data available
 - b. What are the court processes across the State related to discharges from YRTC
 - c. What services are currently available when leave YRTC
 - i. What services are frequently recommended but not available when youth leave YRTC?
 - d. Are 60-day hearings and re-entry hearings functioning as intended to promote smooth transitions from YRTC to the community? If not, what would help bridge the gap?
 - e. When is a new YLS completed (before re-entry, after re-entry, or both?)
 - f. Are any further assessments completed

- iii. Youth unsuccessfully released from probation within one year of YRTC commitment
- iv. Youth receiving new juvenile charges within one year of YRTC commitment
- v. Youth receiving new adult charges within one year of YRTC commitment
