





The total number of youth active in the program as of May 2, 2018 was 267 Youth's who do not have a funding eligibility decision as of the last day of the previous month will not appear in this data.









Percent of State Wards Exiting Care at Age 19 Who Enrolled in B2I within 30 Days of Exit





Age Outs

1. The youth must have had a legal status of either 'HHS Ward' or 'Both OJS and HHS Ward' at the time of exit.
2. The youth must have been in either an Out of Home or Independent Living placement at the time of exit.
3. The youth must have exited within 7 days of their 19th birthday. The seven days allows for data entry errors.

B2I

1. The youth must have been in the Age Out population.
2. The youth must be participating in B2i within 30 days of aging out.





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
