


## History







## History Since January 2018

- Majority of the young adults live in an apartment or house.
- B2i has experienced 1 to 2 young adults per month residing in a homeless shelter.
- Variance for dorm residence combined with meals provided and no meals provided has averaged between 8-14 young adults per month.
- Host Homes have increased as the lowest number of host homes is 2 as a residence for young adults with the highest usage of 10.
- Adult Family Homes (DD) has ranged from 13 to 18.



**Strengths/Opportunities:**


- IC's will update the program category in the expert system when YA's change programs

**Action Items:**


- Train IC's on the expert system










### State Wards Exiting Care at Age 19 Who Enrolled in B2I within 30 Days of Exit

Percent of State Wards Exiting Care at Age 19 Who Enrolled in B2I within 30 Days of Exit




