

Update from Trafficking Subcommittee – January 10, 2019

From now through June 2019, the Trafficking Subcommittee will be working on identifying and compiling policy recommendations on the appropriate response to minors (under 19) who are trafficking victims where no caregiver is involved. Currently, DHHS does not accept these cases for assessment or services and there are concerns that some youth are falling through the cracks.

By June 2019, the Committee hopes to compile a white paper with policy recommendations, including:

- How public systems should respond to these cases and the roles of different agencies;
- Available funding streams; and,
- Needed services.
