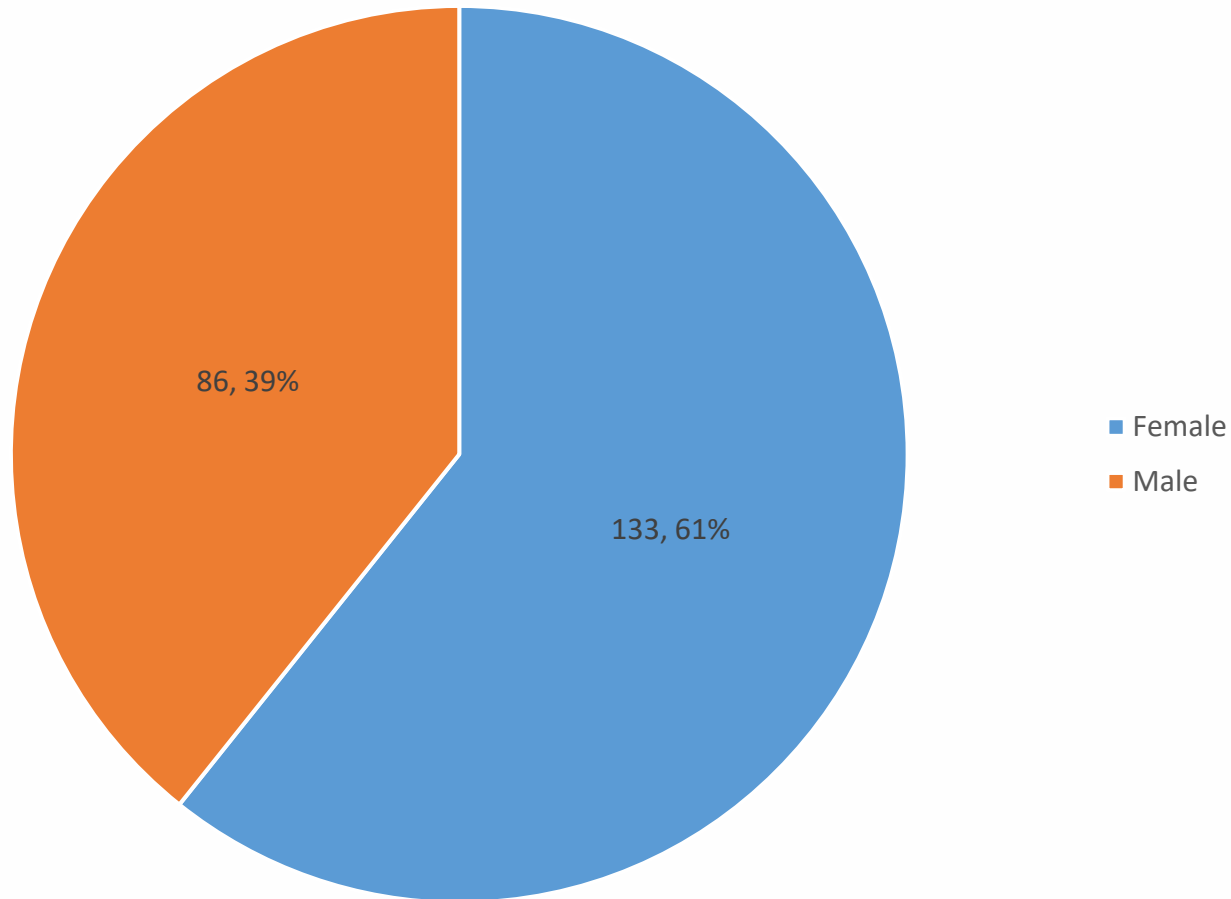

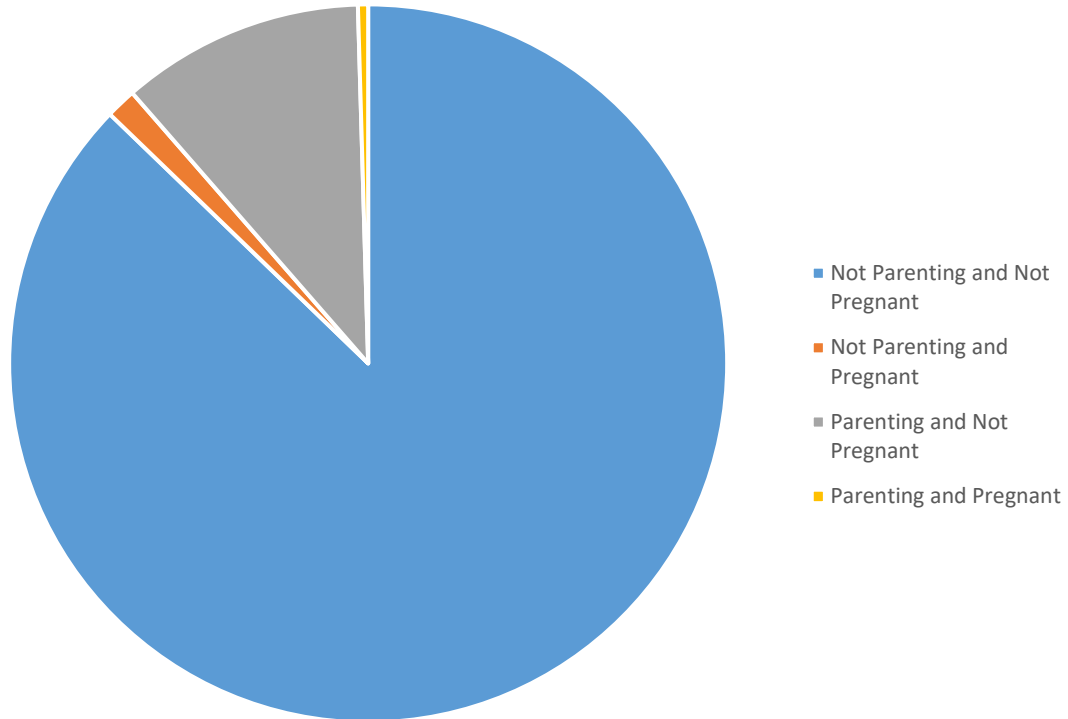

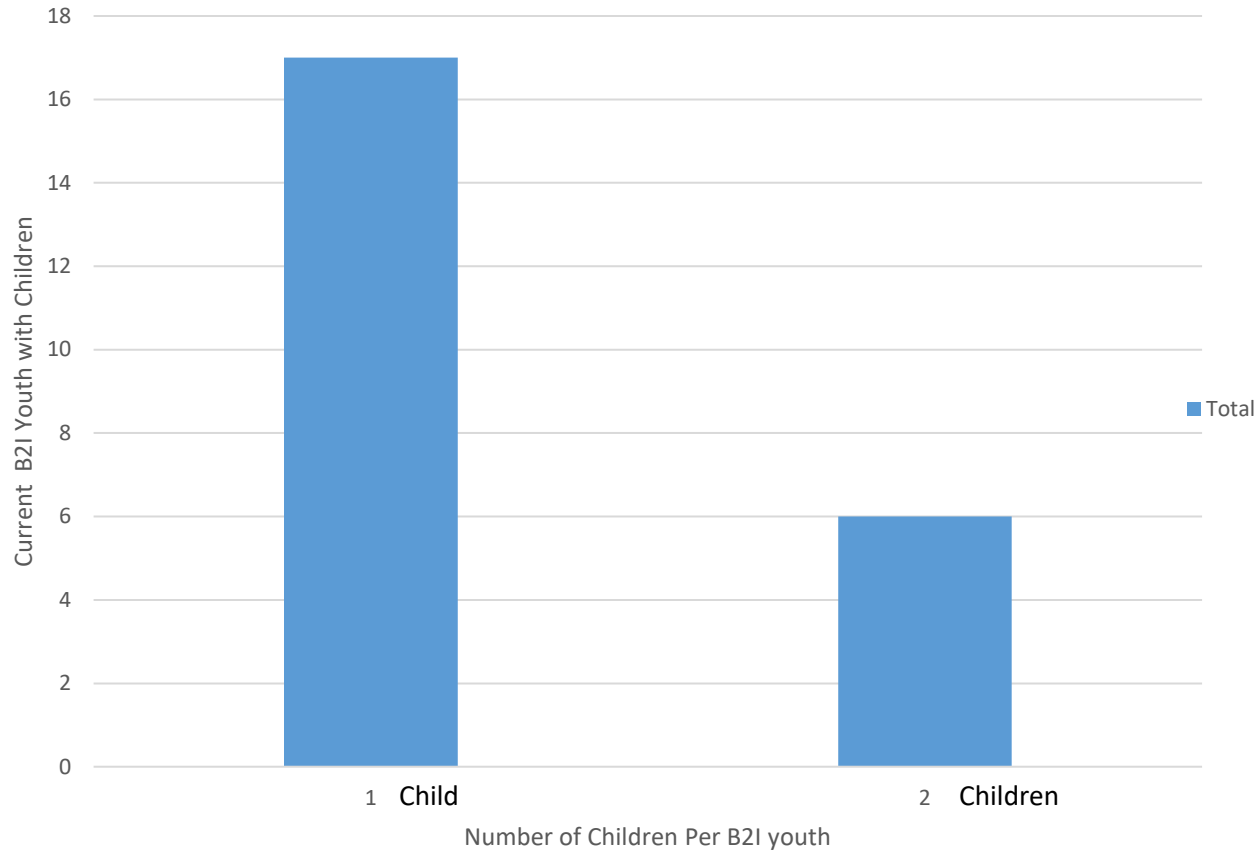

B2I Youth Pregnant and Parenting



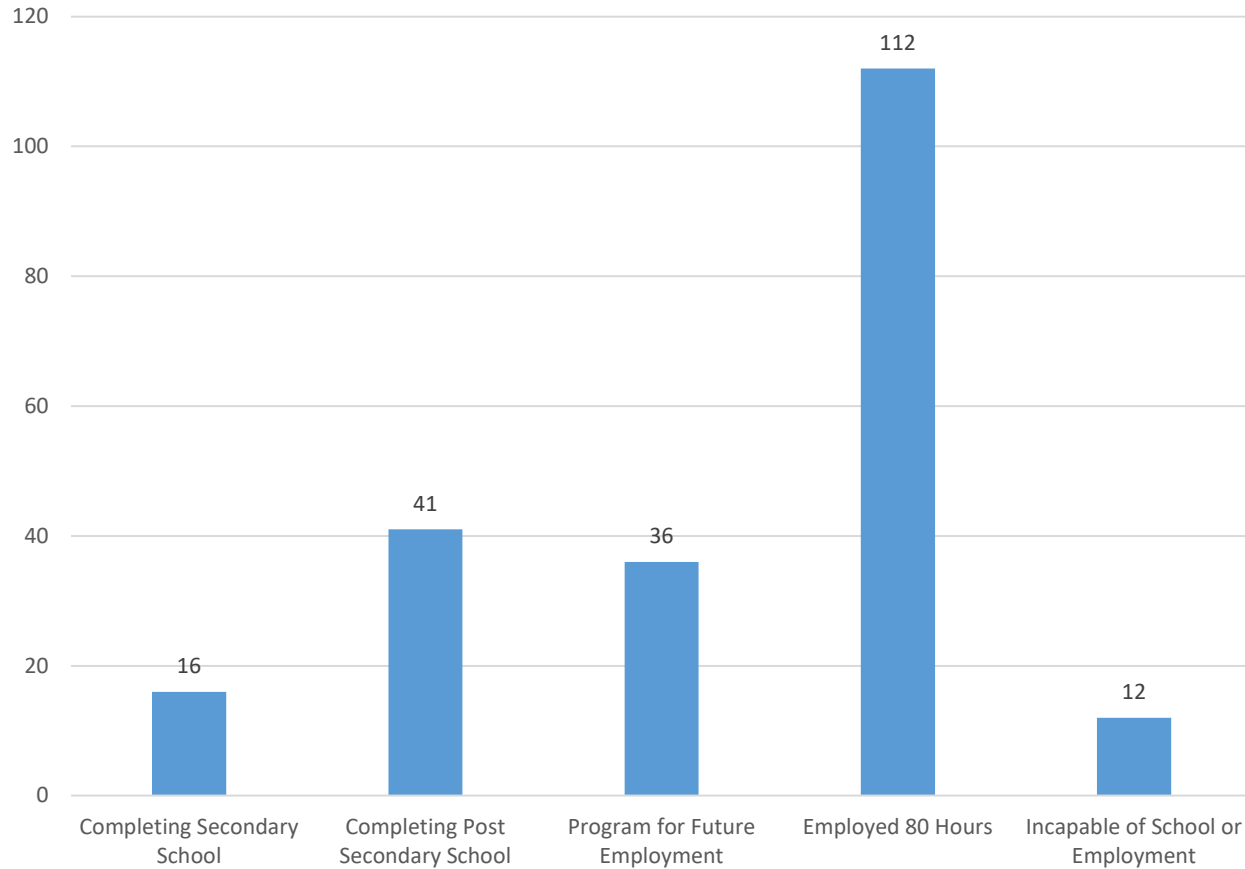

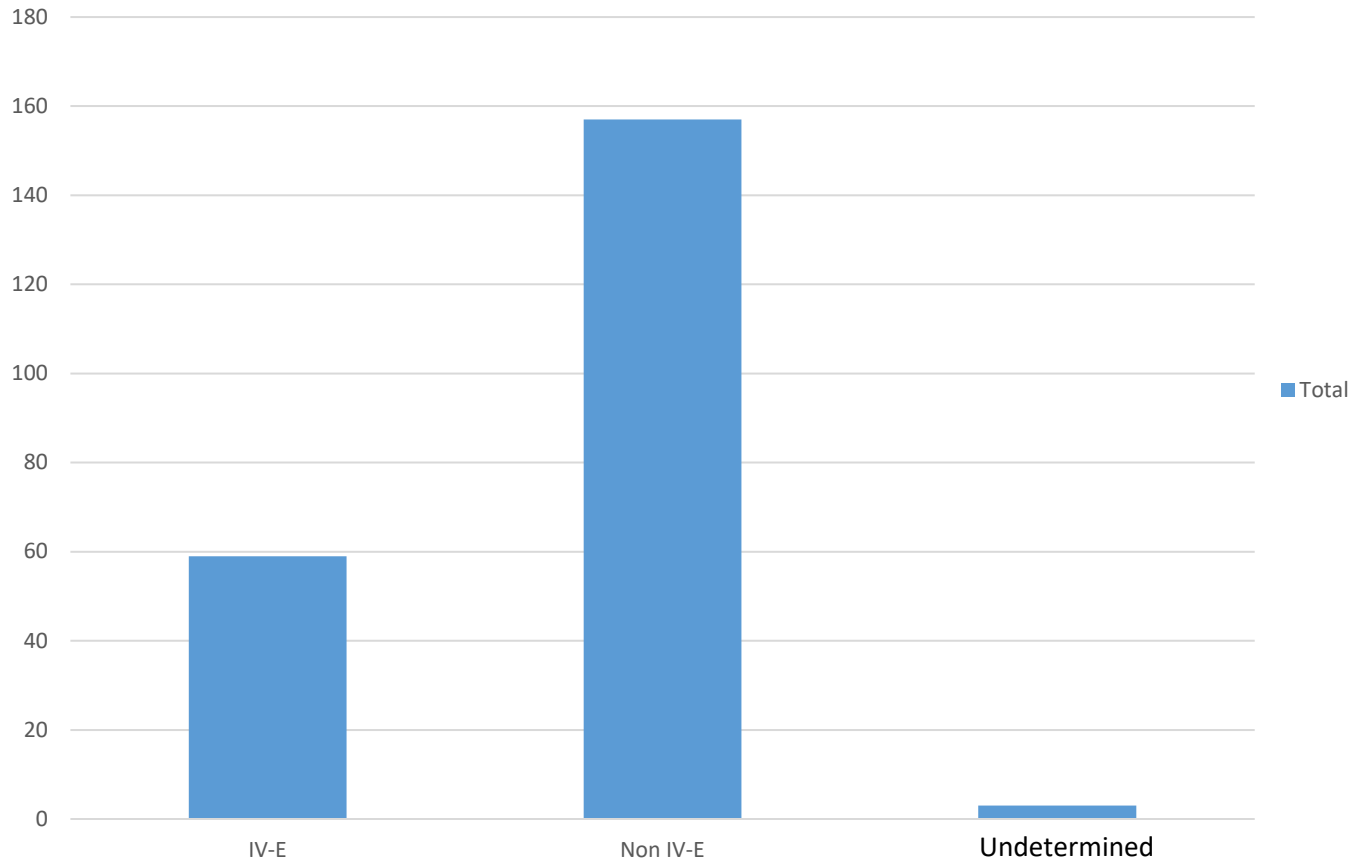

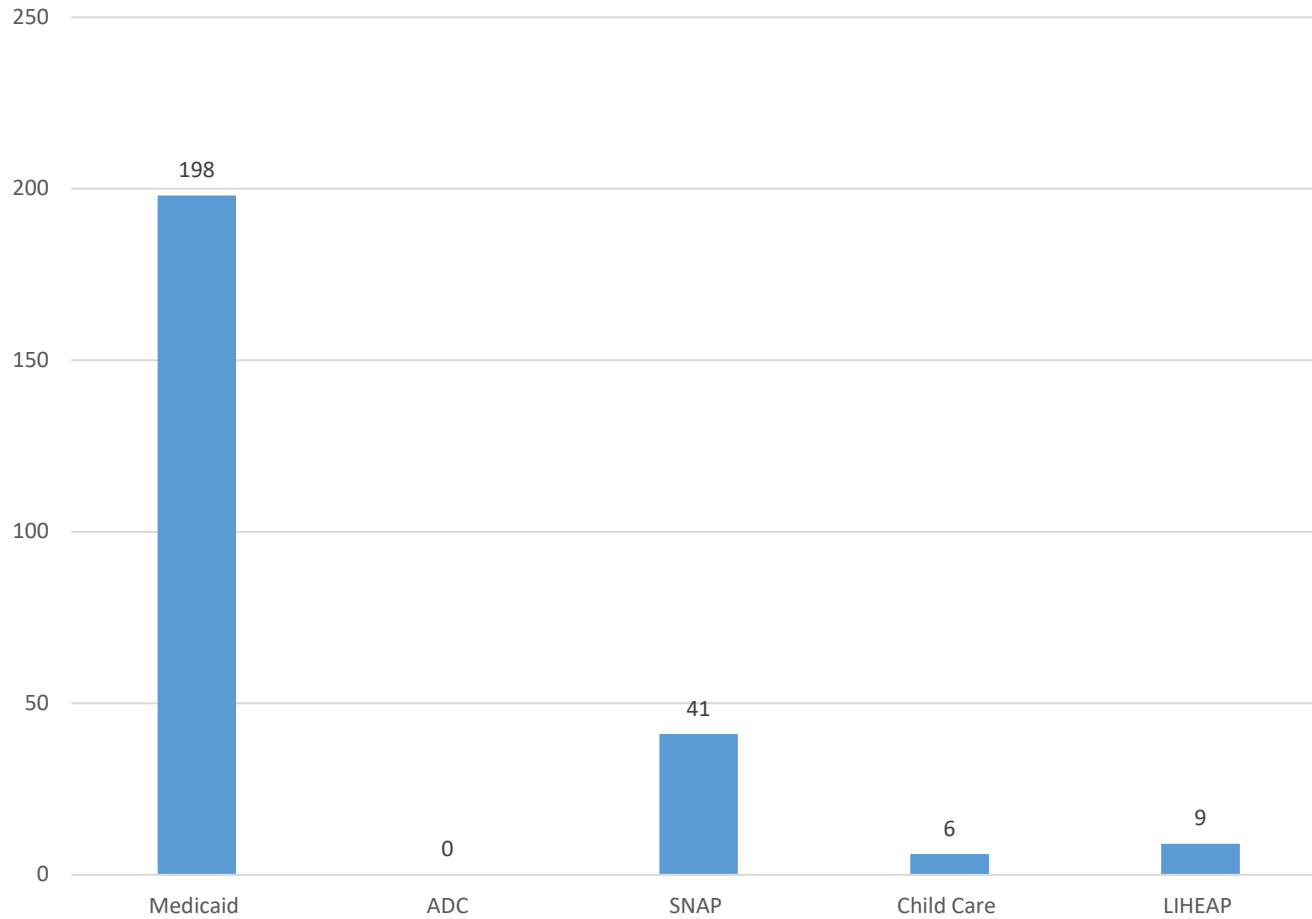

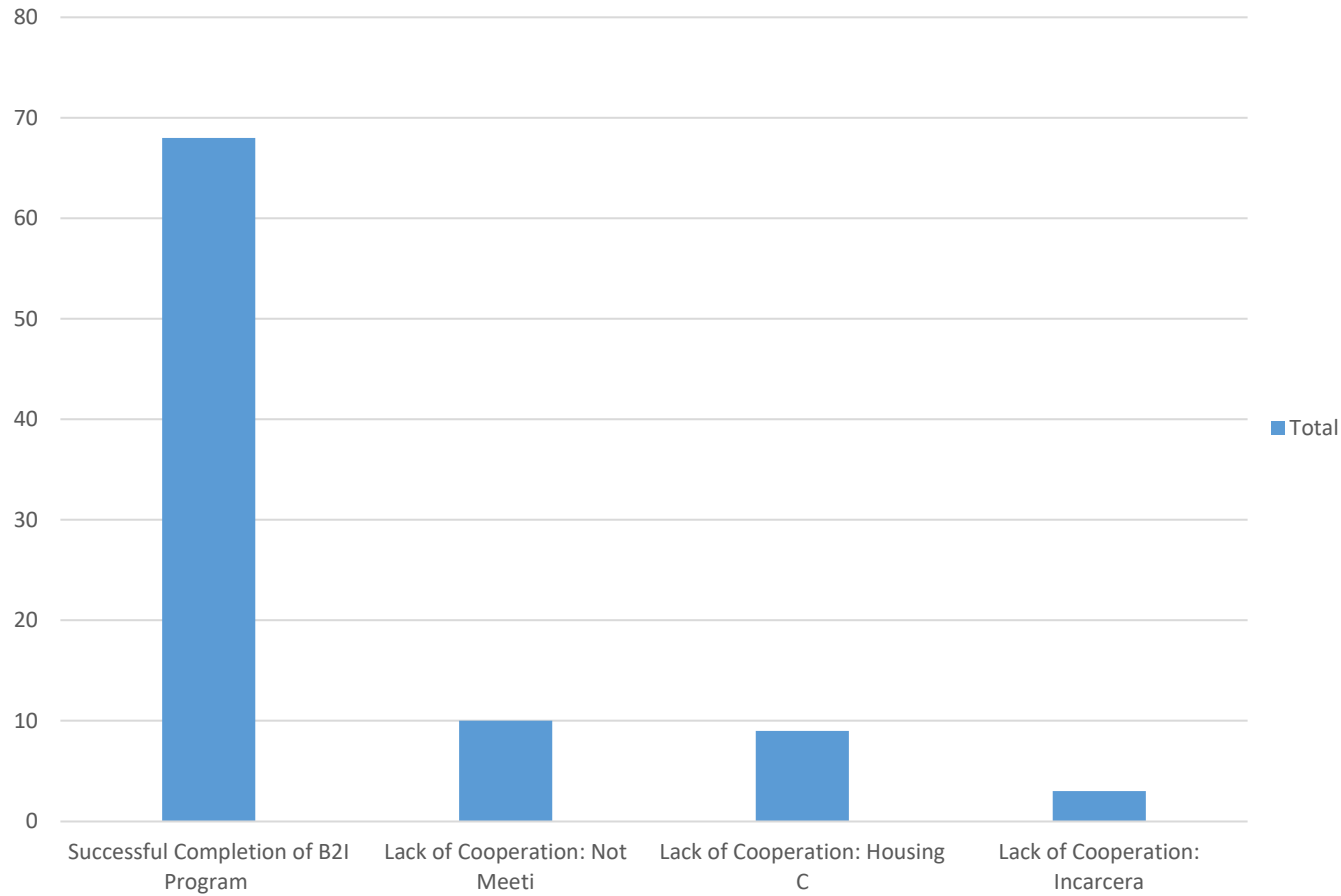

B2i Exit Reasons 2021

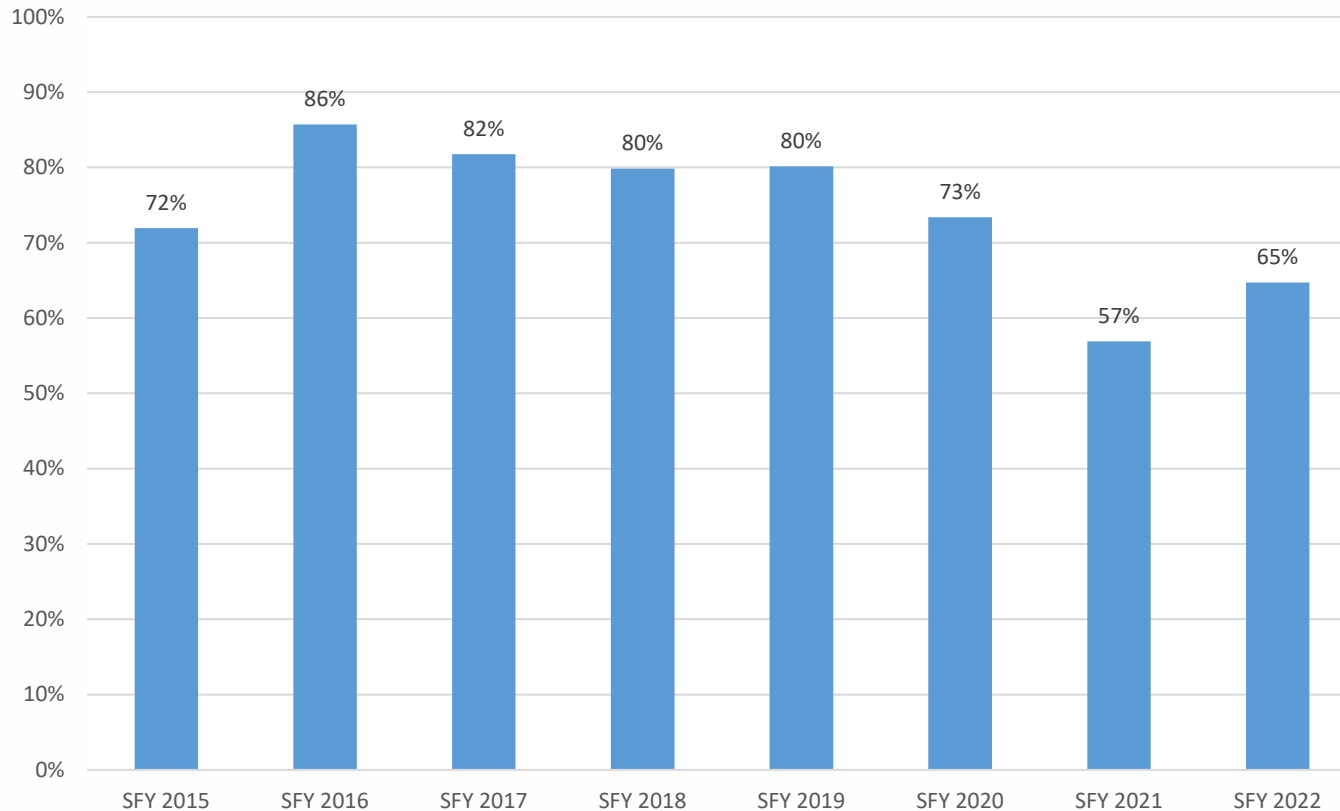

B2i Percentage of enrollment within 30 days

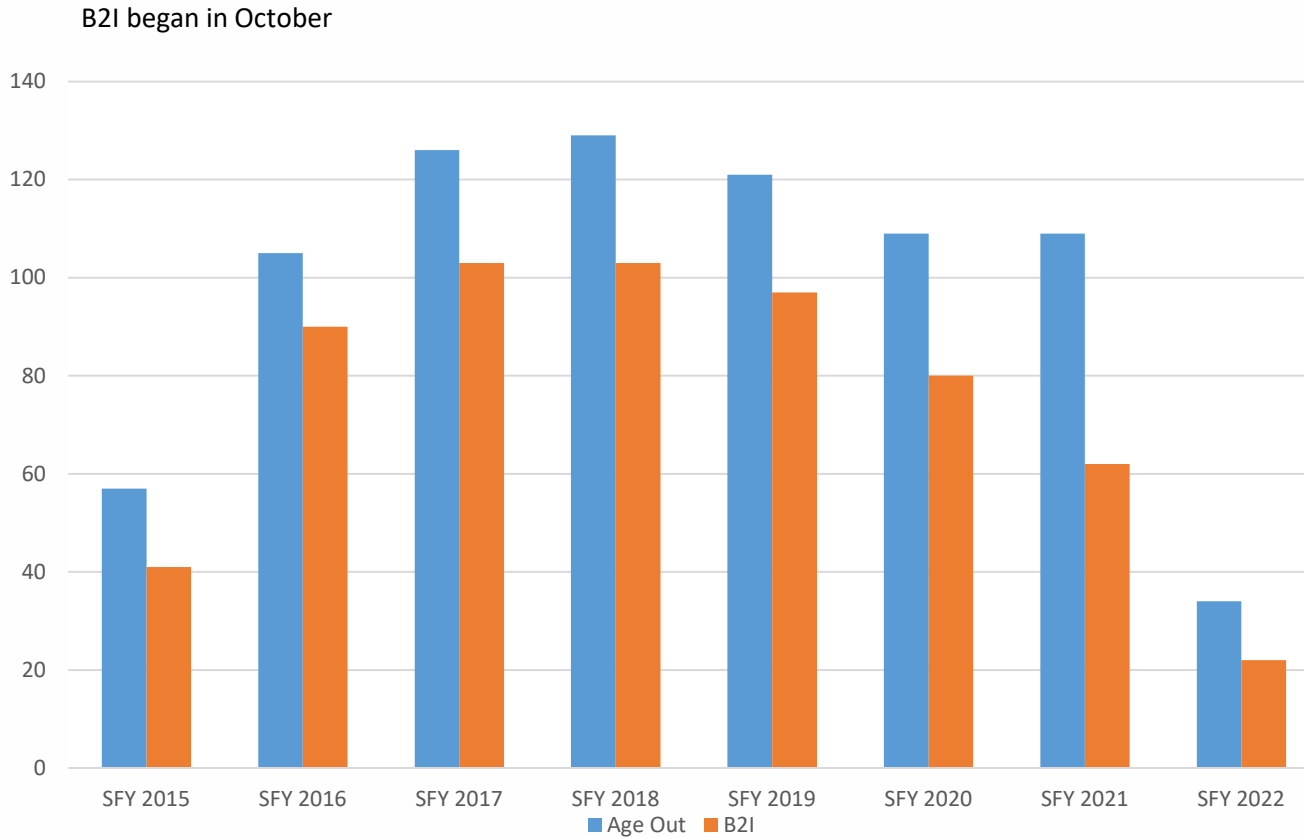
Percent of State Wards Exiting Care at Age 19 Who Enrolled in B2i within 30 Days of Exit

SFY 2020 is through October 2020



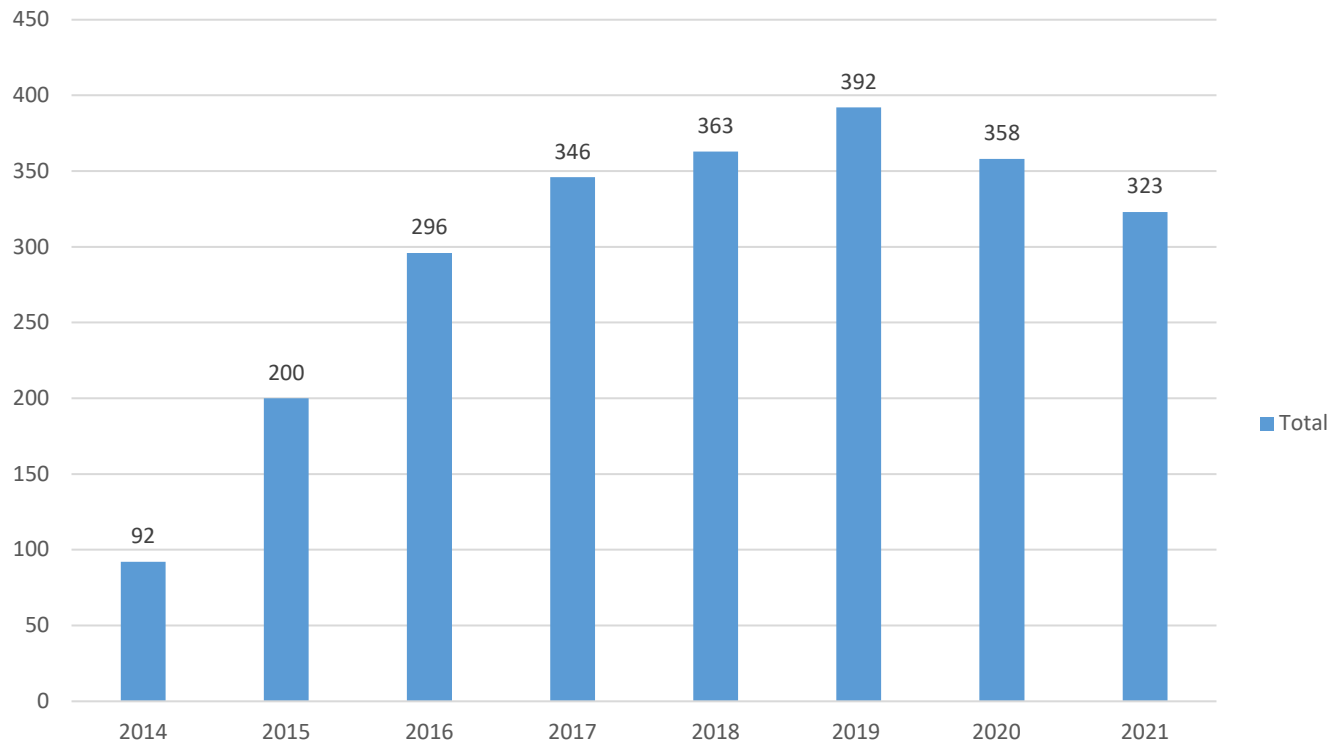
Number enrolled within 30 days
