
Juvenile Services Committee Workgroup Updates July 2021

In October of 2020, the Committee created three new workgroups tasked with specific priorities:






Goal: examine racial and ethnic disparities within the juvenile justice system and create a plan to address disparities within the scope of the Committee.


- 1. Create Map (including prevention/pre-law enforcement systems)
- 2. Match available data with map points
- 3. Identify missing data areas
- 4. Share map and data with identified groups/communities

Goal: The YRTC Workgroup was established by the Committee to reexamine our statutory charge related to YRTC's and to assess the 5-year plan DHHS submitted to the legislature in accordance with NRS 43-427.

Three focus areas:

- 1. Youth Voice
- 2. Family Engagement
- 3. Accreditation



Goal: The Workgroup was established to assess in-state residential treatment options and identify gaps to be addressed.

Next Step:

The Workgroup is currently drafting a survey to help assess the mental health service needs for youth involved in Probation.
