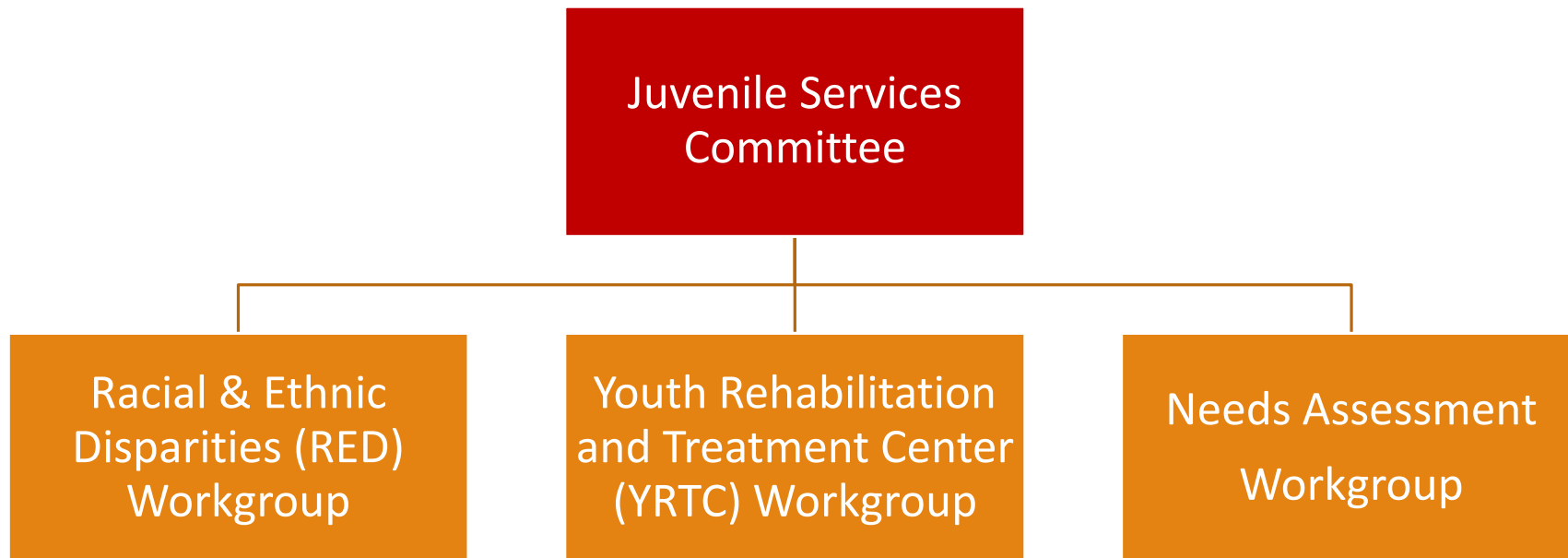




# JSC Committee Structure

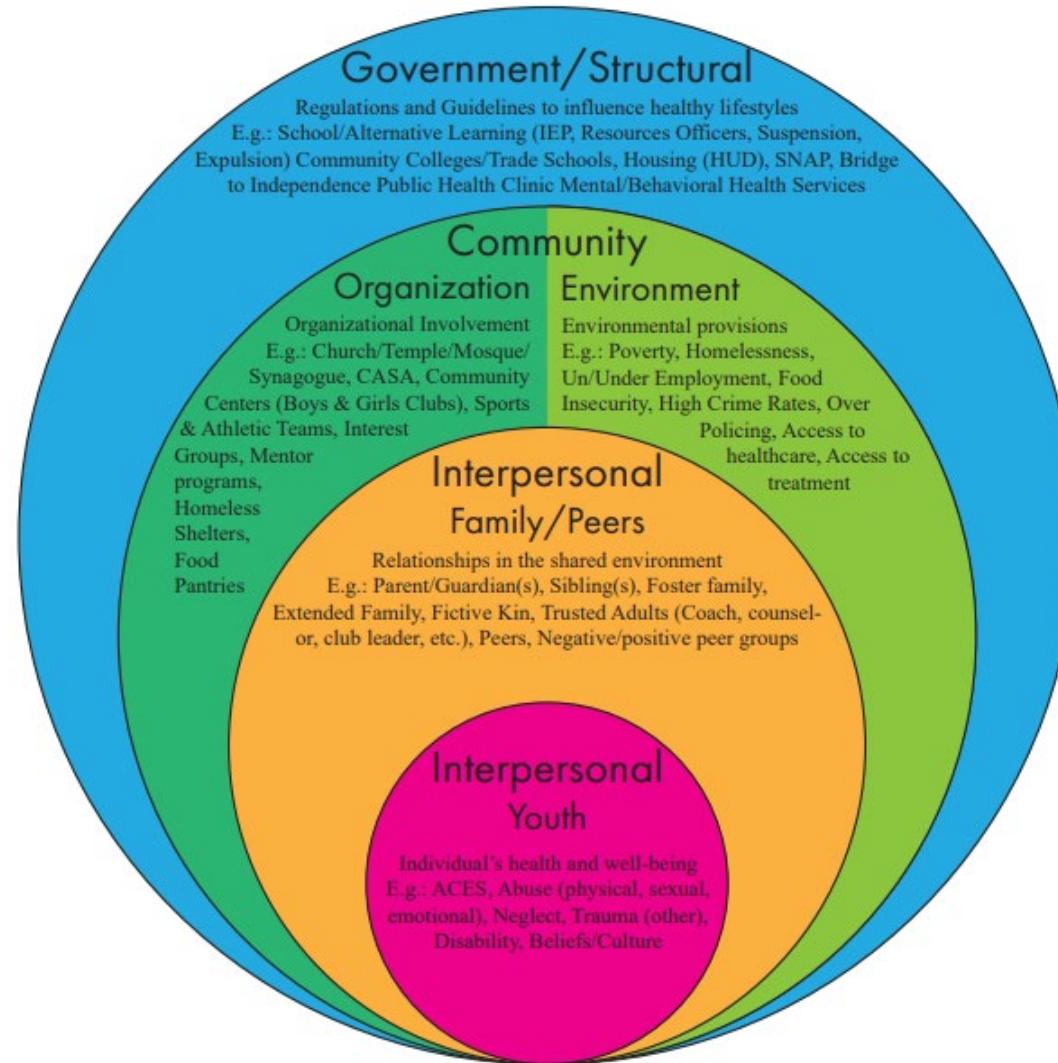

- 4. Share map and data with identified groups/communities*

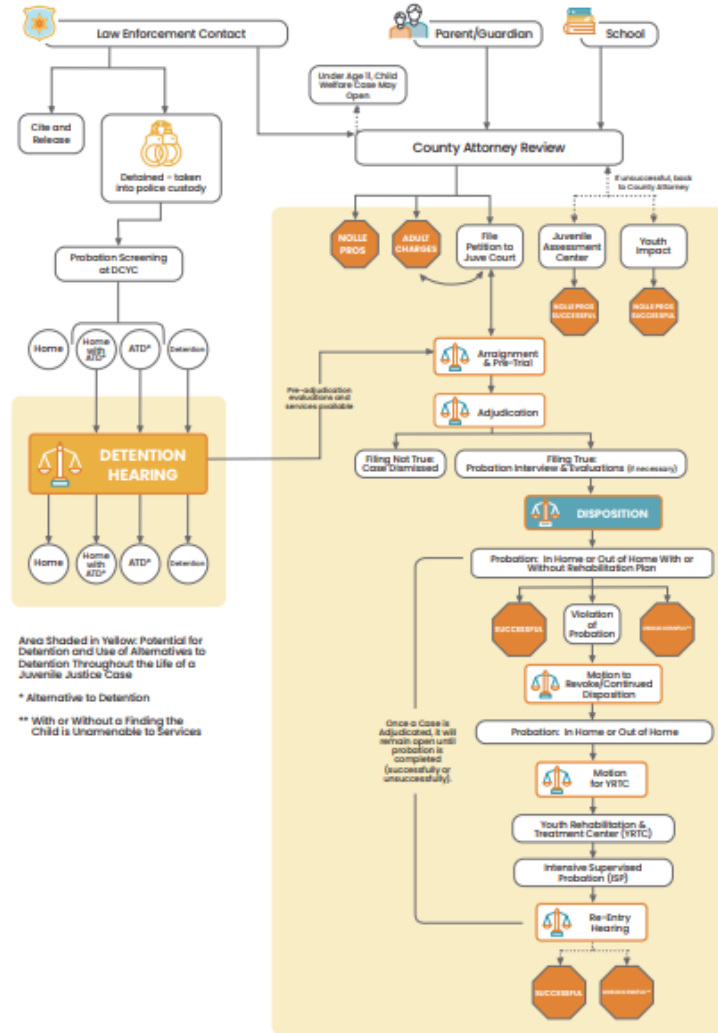


# Juvenile Justice Prevention (Pre-Police) Ecological Map
