## FCRO B2i Dataset Description

- FCRO maintains an administrative B2i case review dataset.
- Data is compiled using information received from CFS on B2i program
  participants, through FCRO staff research review on participants using NFOCUS,
  and additional information received via Young Adults and / or interested party
  questionnaires (mostly Independence Coordinators, some attorneys/GALs).
- This FCRO dataset includes only B2i participants (past and current).
- Data is collected upon monthly reviews, representing a sample of B2i participants enrolled in the program.
- The age of the dataset population is 19- and 20-year-olds.



### FCRO B2i Dataset Use

- Much of the data is limited to the information as collected by CFS or contained within CFS narratives.
- **Demographic** fields and information on number of **times in out-of-home care** as a minor, number of **lifetime placements**, and number of **times missing from care** have recently been added to the FCRO dataset (as available from previously collected data on children and youth in an out-of-home placement).
- Information on this data has rarely been shared beyond recommendations to interested parties; however, we are looking to improve data sharing as appropriate related to this Young Adult population.






# Reviews Completed from August 2018 through December 2021 (n=744)






# County Coverage of Reviews Completed in FY2021




















## Progress on **Transportation**

Overall progress toward independent living is determined by FCRO staff using their professional judgement to measure the combined progress or status in the following areas:





First Review Group Versus Subsequent Review Group










By Times in Care Count



#### Progress to Independent Living










4 or More Times in Care as a Child/Youth (n=15)





By Care Placement Count

10 or More Care Placements as a Child/Youth (n=68)




### **Housing Stability Influence**






### Reliable Support System Influence Progress to Independent Living is more likely to be Yes when Reliable


