## Robert F. Kennedy National Resource Center for Juvenile Justice Probation System Review

- Currently being conducted (June 2021 launched and report Fall 2022), examines four areas: administration, probation supervision, intra and inter-agency work processes, and quality assurance
- •Includes a probation order analysis coducted by The Gault Center
- Quarterly Discussion Group Meetings, additional virtual meetings upon request of RFK staff
- •A probation staff survey will be a component of the review
- Examination of policy, training, probation practices, court practices, org. charts, legislature, CQI, etc.
- Review of recommendations and finding with leadership and release of the report
- Fall 2022 through September 2023, implementation support of prioritized recommendations

National Center for Juvenile Justice Data Capacity Assessement

- Data Capacity System Assessment will compliment the Probation System Review (report Fall 2022)
- •The assessment will be conducted in person and virtually.
- •The Chief Probation Officers will have a meeting with staff from NCJJ
- •The District DDAs will have a virtual meeting with staff from NCJJ
- •There will be a staff survey for probation officers and district leadership
- Fall 2022 through September 2023, implementation support of prioritized recommendations

The Impact Center at FPG Implementation Science Support

- Provide education and tools on key Implementation Science Concepts that support system change
- During the assessment and grant timeframe, focused efforts on building staff and system readiness through a combination of on site and virtual meetings with identifed leadership members
- Administrative staff and Chief Probation Officers
- Provide strategies to prioritize recommendations from the assessments, development of teaming structures and CQI to ensure fidelity to the outcomes

National Youth Screening and Assessment Partners Trauma Screening and Services

- Support selection and implementation of a trauma screening tool, as well as support streamlining current behavioral health screening practices
- Provider engagement to evaluate availablity of appropriate trauma treatment services and capacity of these services
- Conduct in person site visits and trainings, as well as virtual implementation support.
- Planning stages for ongoing support with the implementation team
