Strategic Priorities Process

Strategic Planning Process:

1. Process Overview
2. Existing priorities
3. Small Groups:
 - a. Each group will have 3-5 members
 - b. Task is to determine up to 3 priorities for the large group to consider
4. Large Group:
 - a. sharing of small group priorities
 - b. Consolidate any priorities with similar themes
 - c. BREAK (during break, new priority ideas will go up on large sticky notes)
 - d. Each member has 3 small sticky notes and will then distribute them to their desired priorities
 - e. Top 3-5 most popular items will become our new priorities
5. Next meeting we will spend time in small groups to create an action plan for each item
