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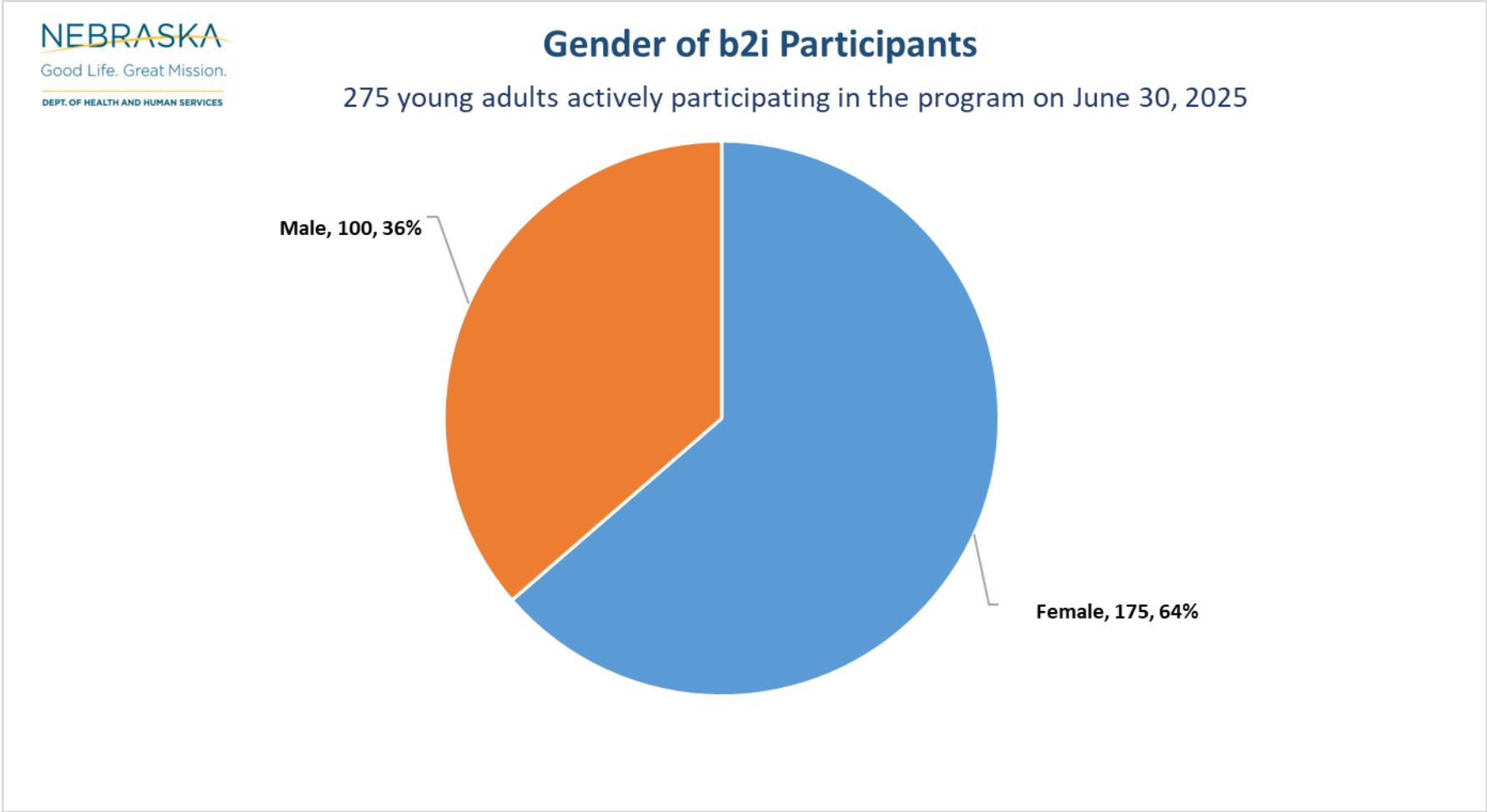
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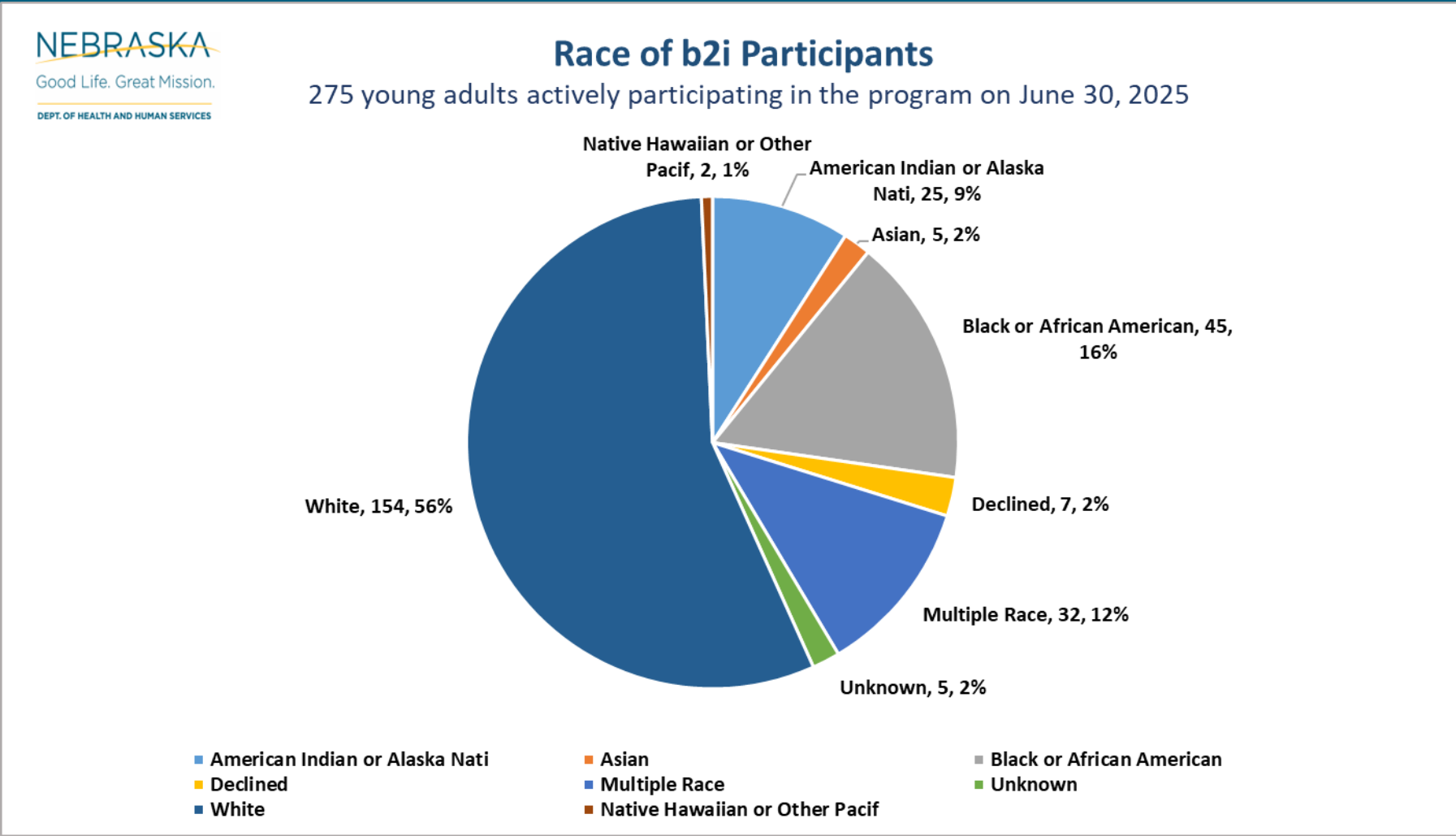
b2i Young Adults Participation in 2025

- **347 unduplicated young adults actively participated in the b2i program from January to June 2025** **this includes young adults who entered the program prior to January 1st, 2024.*
- **72 unduplicated young adults exited the program between January – March 2025.**
- **275 young adults remain as active participants as of July 8, 2025.** **this includes young adults who exited but returned to the program again this year.*
 - **Of the 275 active youth**
 - *7 entered from Probation*
 - *68 entered from Guardianship/Adoption*
 - *11 entered from Tribal Court*

b2i Young Adults – Active Participants on 6/30/2025

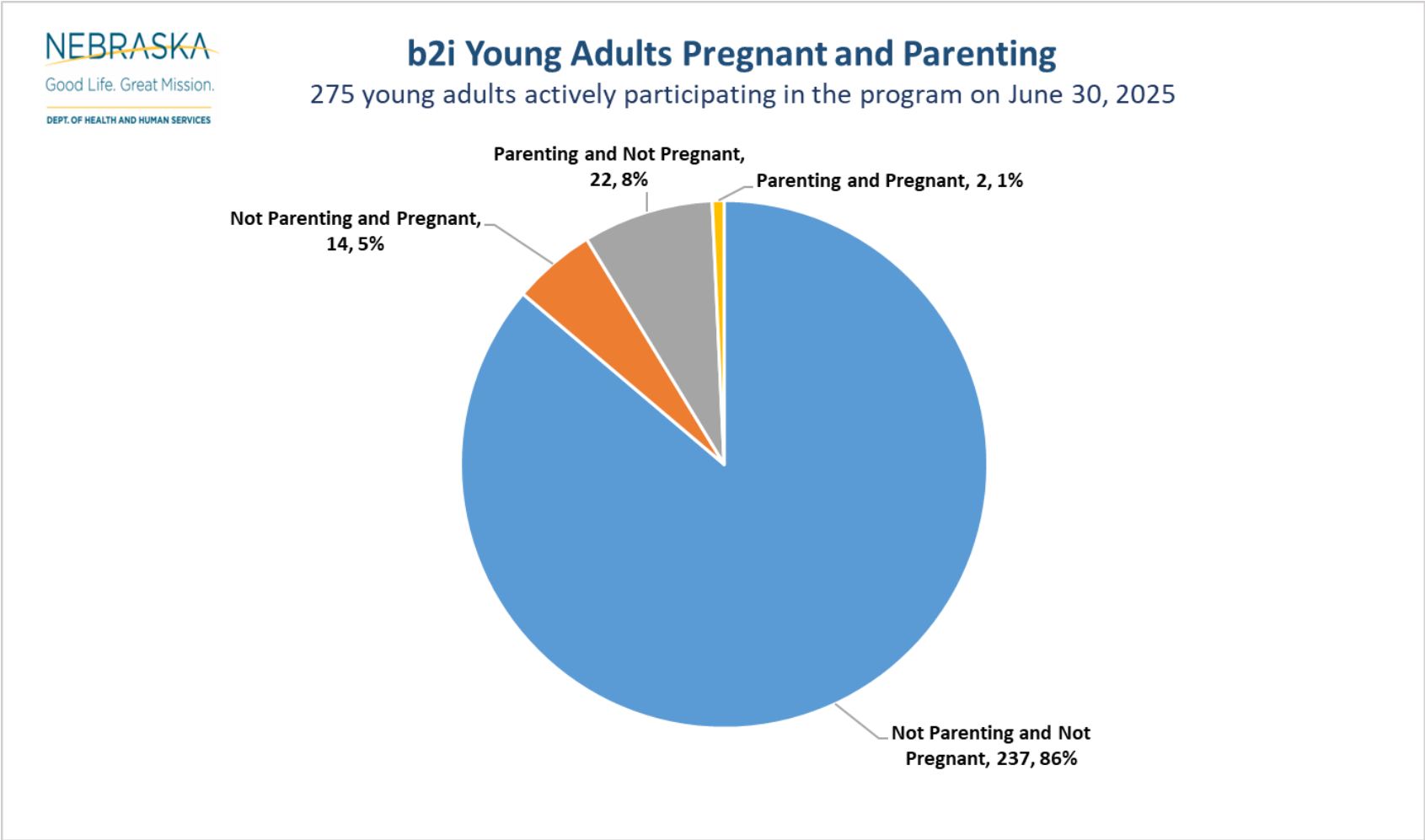


b2i Young Adults – Active Participants on 6/30/2025

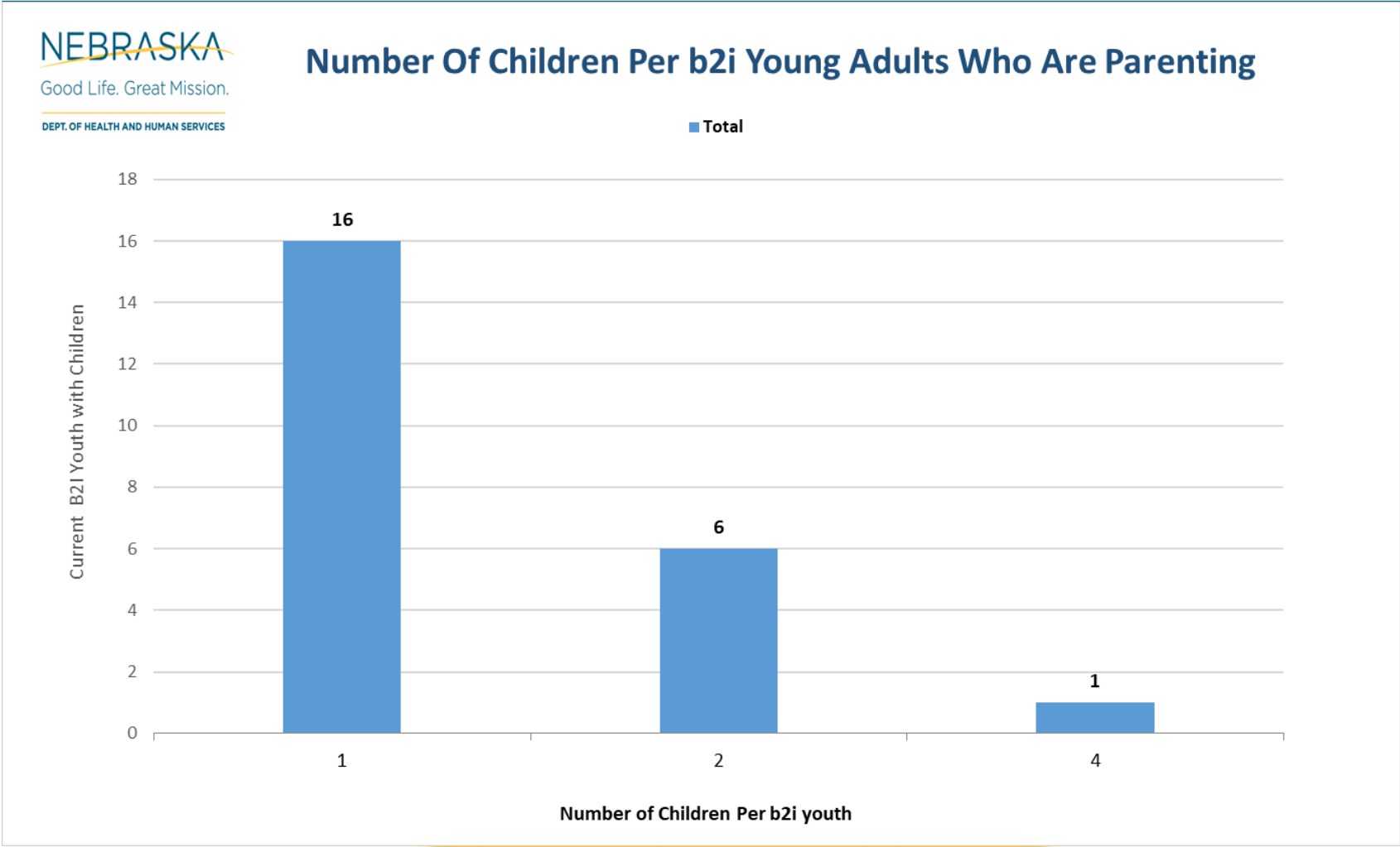

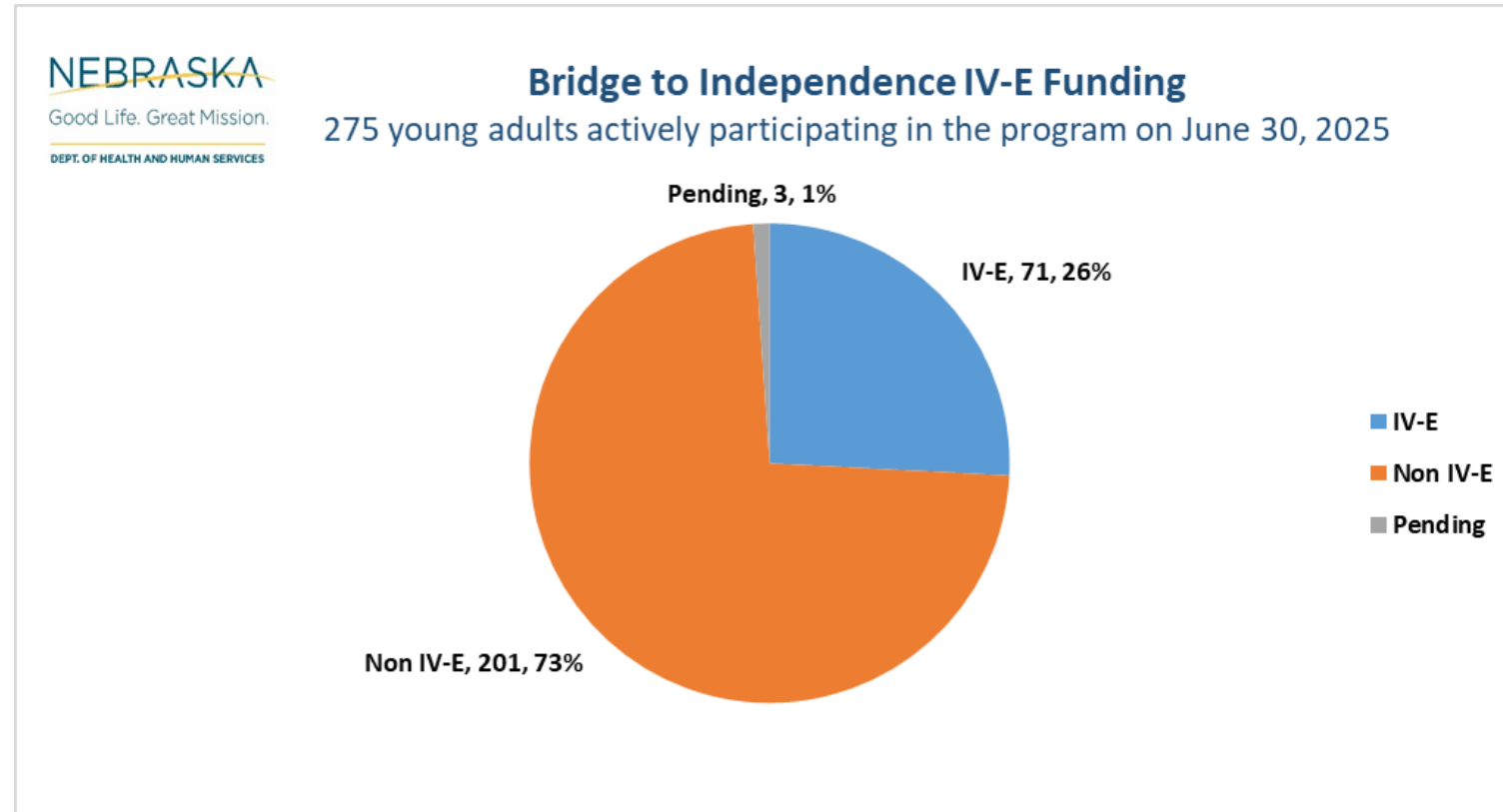

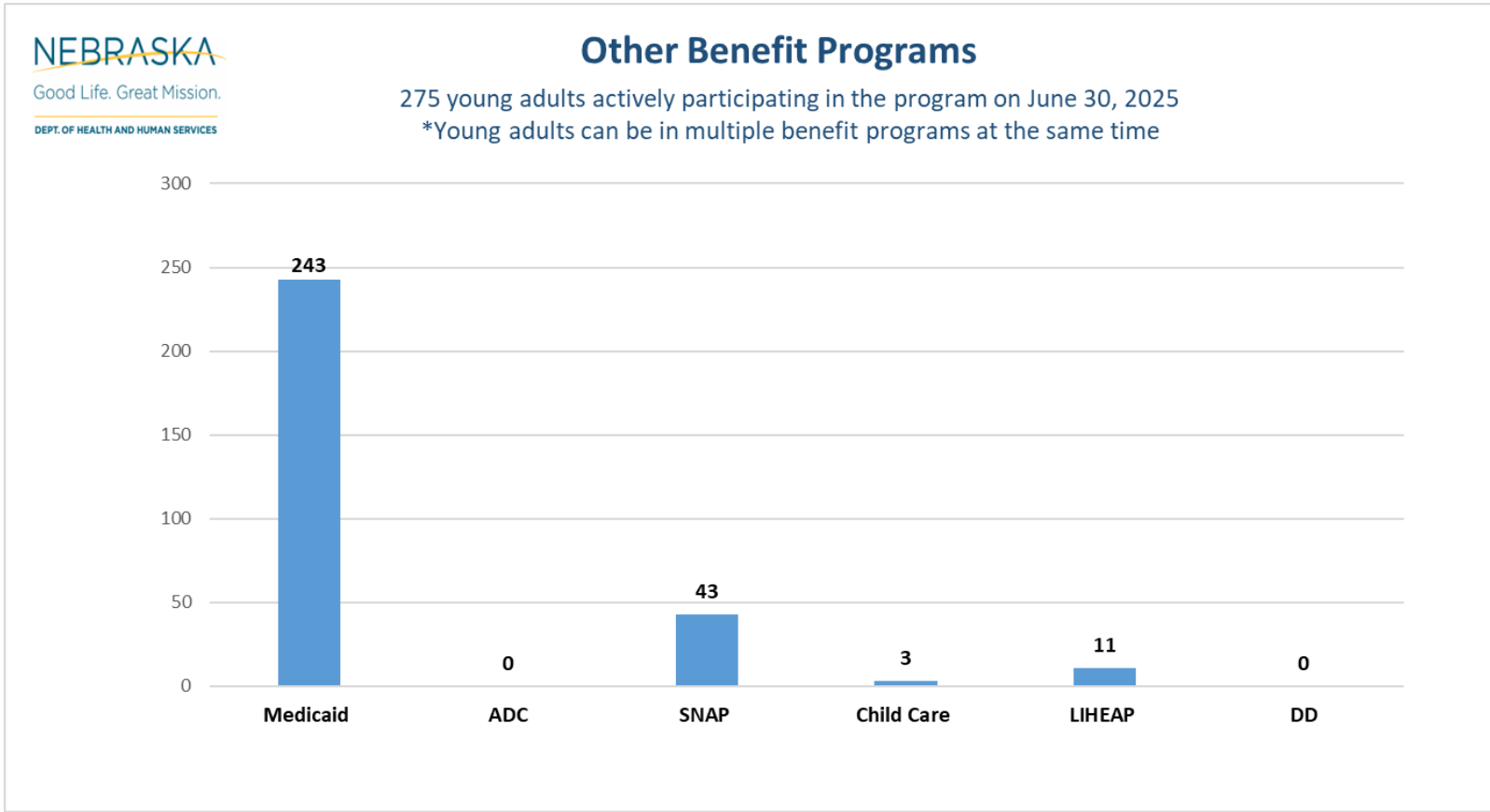

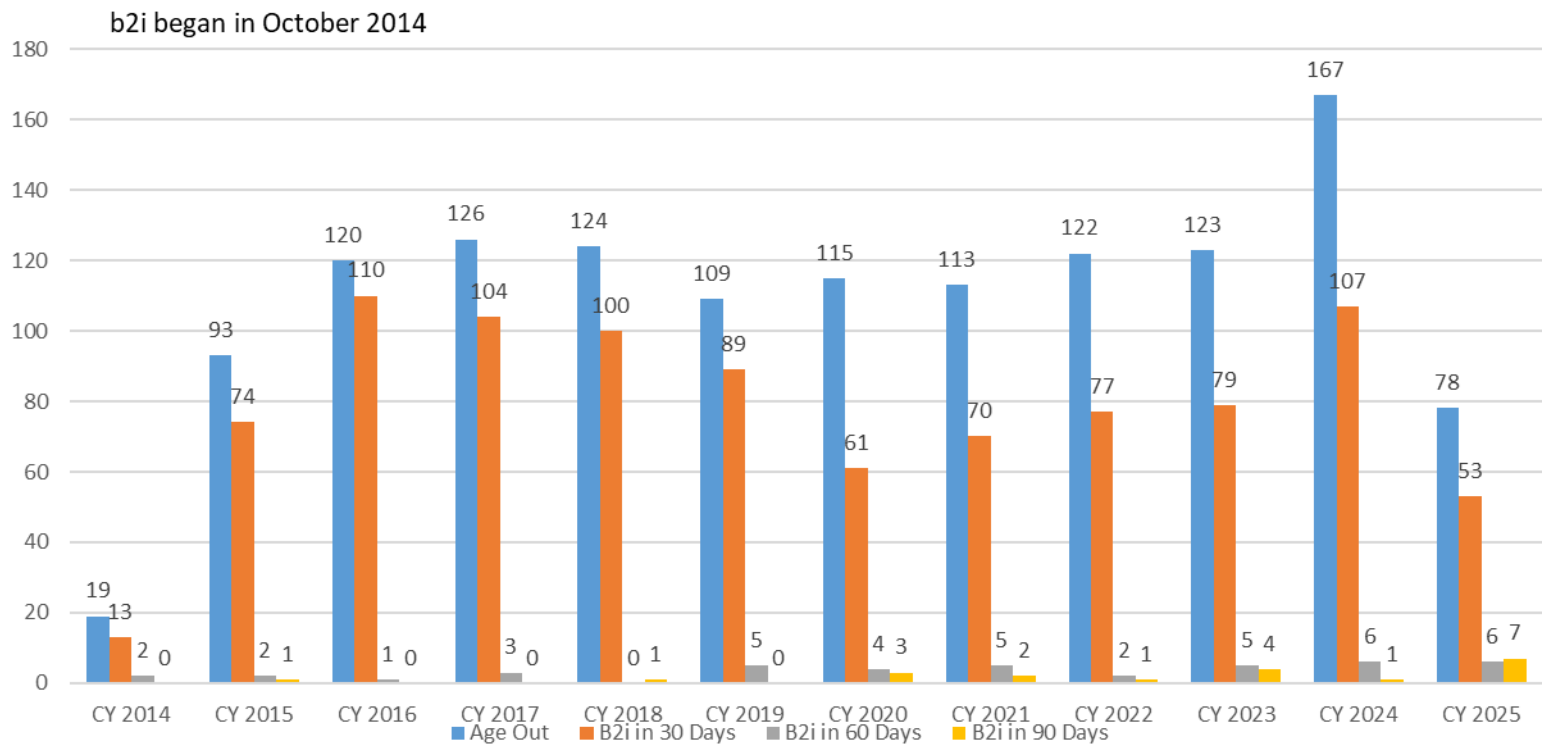

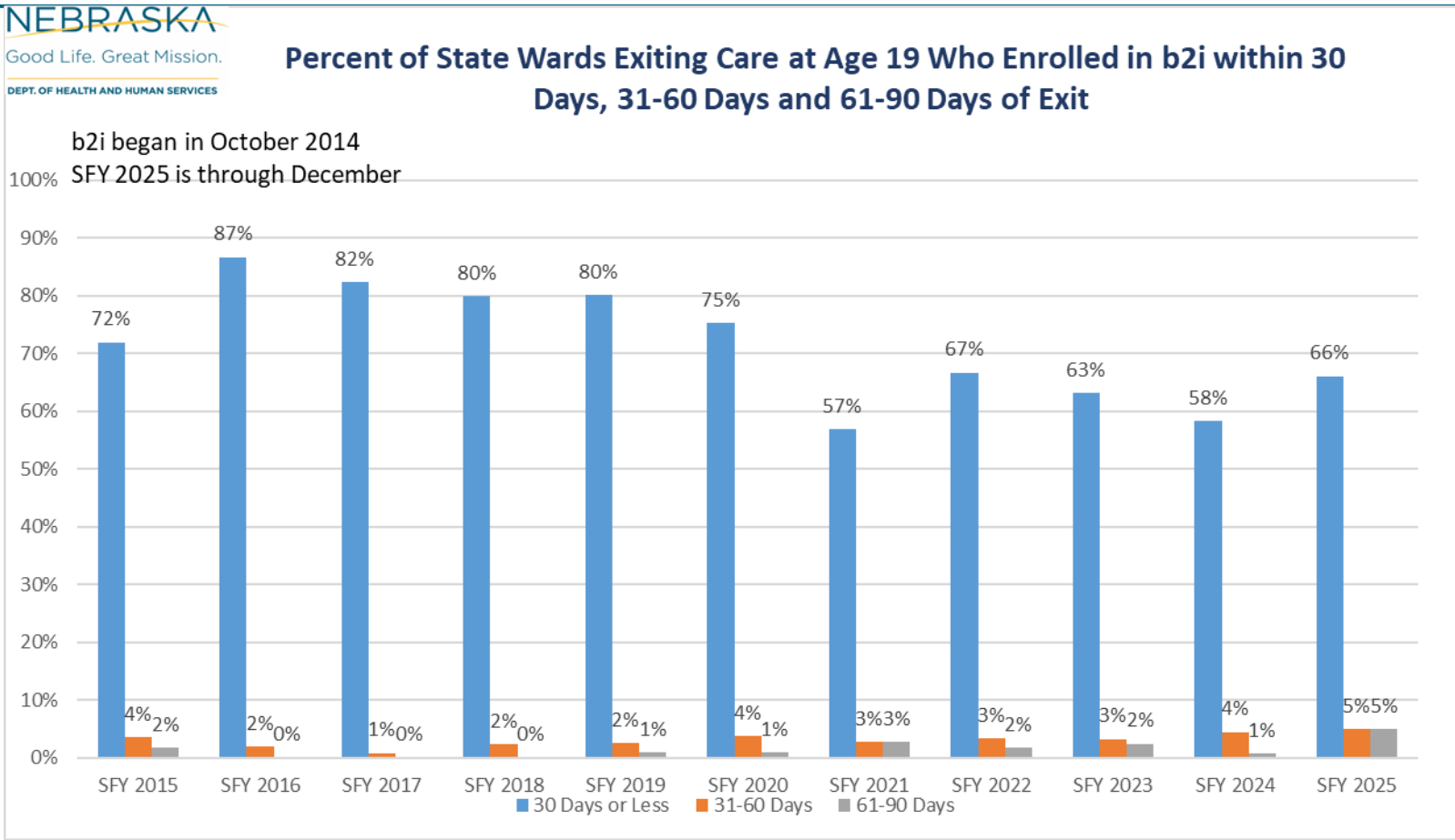
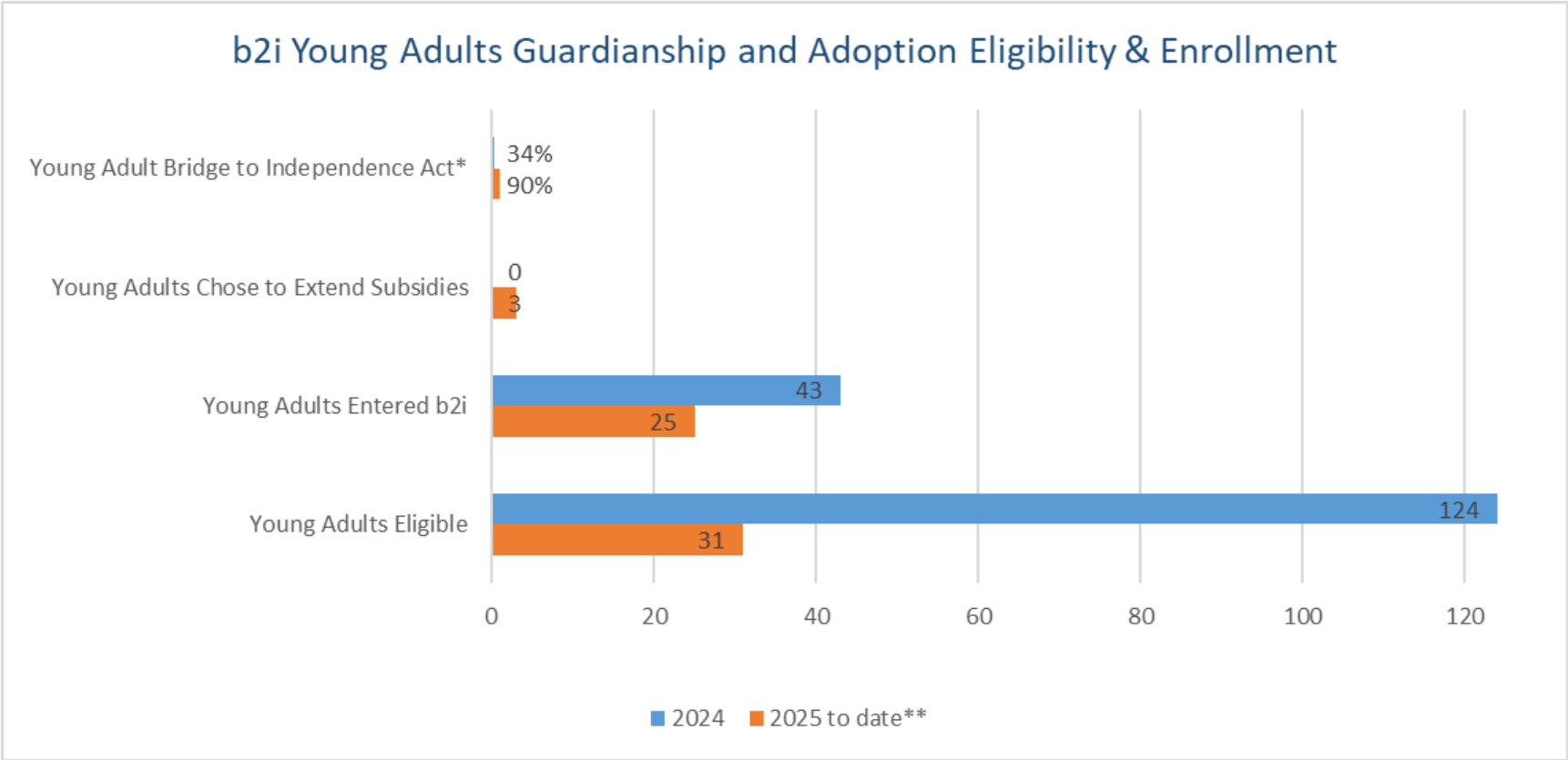

*Young Adult Bridge to Independence Act is calculated by: Entered b2i + Chose Extended Subsidies/Young Adults Eligible*100

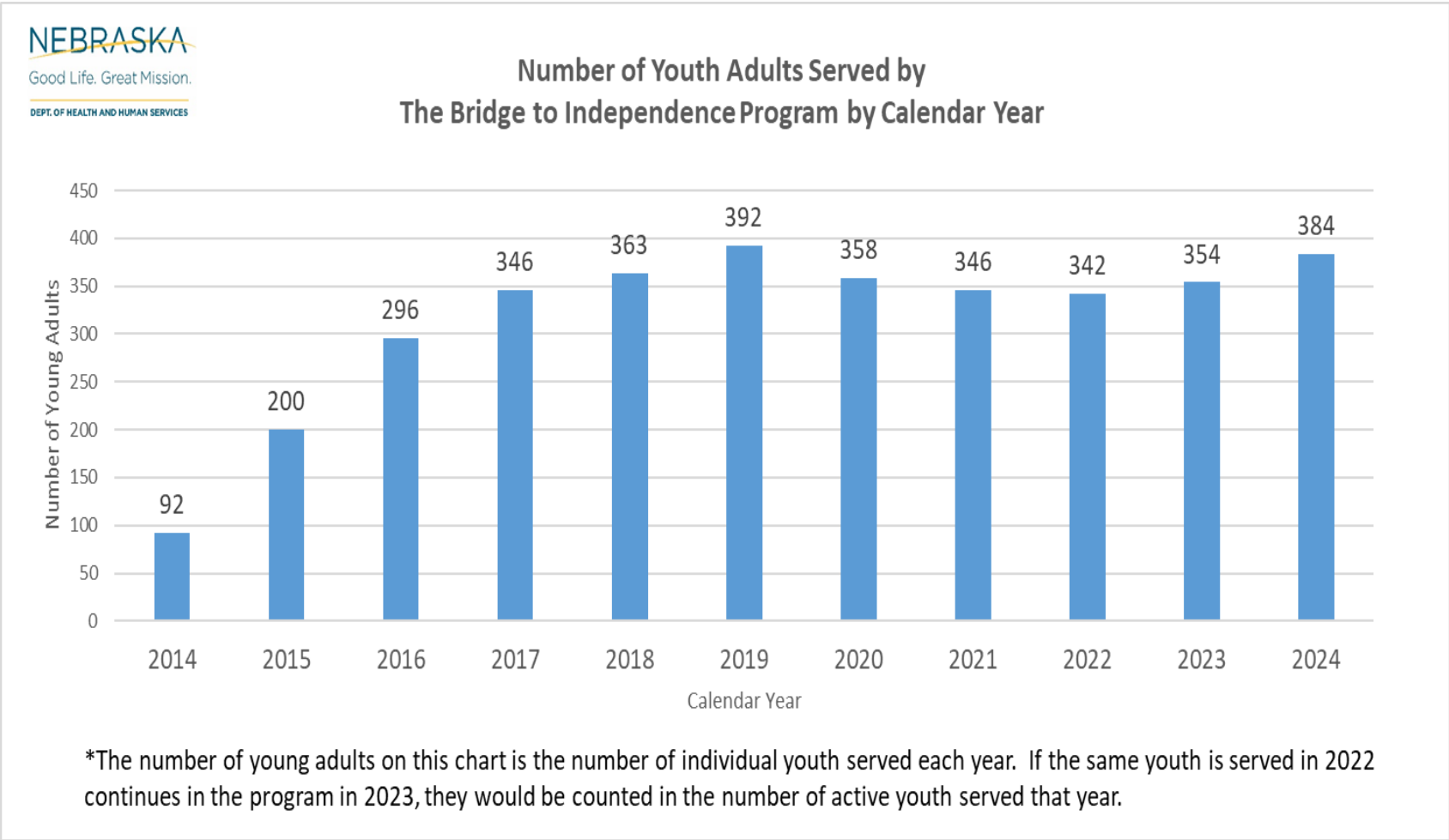
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b2i Unduplicated Young Adults by Year
